

# Understand your power consumption through a NO COST energy efficiency assessment.

SaskPower is partnering with Natural Resources Canada to help Saskatchewan businesses become more energy efficient! For a limited time, businesses with fewer than 500 employees may qualify for a no-cost walk-through energy assessment and energy efficiency training while funding is available or before March 31, 2021.

## 1 – No-cost Walk-Through energy Assessment (WTA):

During a walk-through assessment an energy auditor visits your business. They look for:

- Ways to decrease energy consumption
- Opportunities for energy efficiency
- Ways to save money on natural gas and power bills
- Extensive health and safety precautions will be used to ensure the health and safety of our customers and employees.

The auditor will make recommendations that range up from no-cost. Virtual walk-through assessments are also an option.

## 2 - No-cost online energy management training opportunities:

Through SaskPower's partnership with Natural Resources Canada, we're offering two kinds of energy efficiency training to build energy efficiency skills and knowledge in the province.

1. Energy Management Professional (EMP-101) training which is an introduction to energy management. (3 days virtual classroom training - starting September 29<sup>th</sup>)
2. Certified Energy Manager (CEM) training for energy efficiency professionals that covers the technical, economic and regulatory aspects of effective energy management. (5 days virtual classroom training - starting October 19<sup>th</sup>)
